
No stamps as they floated off while the envelope was in the water.

"Something for nothing" is a phrase used when someone thinks I am of no value but for another person there is value so I change into something.

Another way of expressing something for nothing is to say that it is free.

Individuals and organisations can obtain privileges which entitle them to obtain something for free.

FREE franking for a Member of Parliament in the UK. Late usage of, privilege which was abolished on 10 Jan 1840.

The sender gets a benefit or "something for nothing" but the business still has to pay the charges.




Something for nothing in the form of free mail is a small luxury for prisoners of war who are, in contrast to the wind, constrained.

Prisoner of War Letter from Liverpool, NSW, Australia, Concentration Camp, 23 January 1918 from a civilian.

Although prisoners obtained something for nothing, the authorities controlled the situation and censored the mail.

Mail scarce:- 98 Australians at the camp in 1943-4.

None, Turin Province. Backstamped 7 July (1866.) Zero is not a natural number, as it is not used to start counting, but is a specific symbol for assigning no value.


2.1: OF NO VALUE

Paris was the centre of the pneumatic post system 1st arrondissment, allocated "00" marking.

.. or a location can also be designated or referred to as zero. If I am in the middle of the world I am also at a zero location and I have special names.



Latitude is my name when I am in the middle horizontally.

The Equator (Ecuador in Spanish) is designated as latitude 0° 0′ 0″.

The Equator is only an imaginary line drawn on the Earth's surface so I cannot be seen.

When the earth is divided vertically longitude is what I am called.

Longitude encircles the globe north - south.

Greenwich is considered my home as the Prime Meridian, which passes through the Royal Observatory Greenwich, establishes the position of zero degrees longitude.



The Prime Meridian and International Dateline were established at an international conference in 1884.



2.4.1: DECIMAL SYSTEM



The decimal system has 10 (Ten) as its base and is used by most modern civilizations.

The number 10 is created by adding the "0" to the first number "1".

Plate proof - Postage Due - 10 c value not issued until September 1879. On India card in darker shade than issued stamp.

Scarce in large multiples.



The sequence in the decimal system is such that the value of any position increases by a power of 10 for each move from left to right by adding a "0"

My mate the zero continues to be added with the system progressing in steps of three.

There is a dot or a comma before the last three zeros to obtain the next steps of 10,000 and 100,000.

In some places the system is the same but has a different step with a new name.



And with the addition of more of my alter egos, the numbers get bigger and bigger.

But something may have the appearance of high value which can become worth nothing very quickly!!



A value of 500,000,000,000 Marks transformed into nothing after devaluation by one trillion times on Dec 1 1923.

Well almost nothing. The value was just ½ Mark. (50 Pf) after conversion.



50 new pfennigs, issued Dec 1st, 1923

Express - Breslau >20-100g. . Correct use of German hyperinflation stamps on 10 Dec 1923. Mark devalued on Dec 1 but previous stamps valid for an additional month.
